Please make sure that you read the following information carefully regarding you/your child`s participation and ensure that the following matters are addressed. Also note that if you have received this letter then you/your child are officially eligible to grade.

GRADING INFORMATION

VENUE: Morgan Moss Karate & Sports Conditioning Centre

DATE: Wednesday, 22 March 2023 & Thursday, 23 March 2023 (Official

Grading – Please see table below for specific Times) – Please take note that there is **NO ADDITIONAL OPPORTUNITY TO GRADE** if the

grading is missed.

COST: White/Yellow/Orange Belts = R300

Green/Blue Belts = R 350.

Purple/Brown Belts & All Adults = R 400.

The grading fee is payable in cash before or on the day of the grading in the office (NO EFT). Upon completion of payment and registration, the student will receive his/her grading form to be handed to the panel during the grading. This fee also includes the belt (if applicable), level stripe,

certification and ratification. **NO PAYMENT = NO GRADING**

DRESS: Full karate suit (Gi), belt, (mitts & mouth guard for Blue – Brown Belts).

RESULTS: Handed out directly after the grading.

NB NOTICE: This is a panel grading and all instructors from MMK will be present.

Instructors decisions are final and to be respected.

CRITERIA FOR GRADING

- 1. **Time:** A minimum of fifteen (15) to twenty (20) classes of training is necessary before a student is allowed to grade.
- 2. **Age:** Age does affect how often a student grades (Younger students progress slower).
- 3. **Standard:** The student must know the syllabus for his/her grade at the minimum standard required.
- 4. Attendance: Students who miss more than 3 classes for no reason at all (12 IN THE YEAR), may not grade.
- 5. **Gashkyu:** All grading candidates must attend the full Grading Gashkyu to qualify for the grading (communication will be sent out regarding this if applicable).

GRADING: PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF THE FOLLOWING

- 1. ONLY INVITED STUDENTS MAY GRADE. Students who have not received an invitation or who do not appear on the list of invited students are encouraged to attend the training component as well as the actual test. Attendance will still be recorded as per normal class times.
- 2. Grading fee to be paid in cash on or before the date of grading. NO PAYMENT = NO GRADE.
- 3. Only students whose accounts are up to date will receive grading results. Students development will continue as per normal and the grade will be considered but not issued until this point has been addressed. Under no circumstances will this change.
- 4. Those students who have been invited to grade but are unable to attend the grading on the set date need to inform the dojo of this a minimum of 72 hours prior to the grading so that an alternative arrangement can be made. Failure to do this or nonattendance will result in automatic failure.
