

2023 KARATE FEES EXPLAINED

AFFILIATION FEE

Annual Amount: R 650.00 Deadline: 31 January 2023

The annual affiliation fee is a compulsory fee for all members of the dojo. A member is defined as any student training at the facility (<u>traditional and/or tournament</u>). Through the use of this fee, the dojo and all its members are affiliated to the following regional, provincial, national and international federations:

1. Goju-Ryu Seiwakai International (Japan), JKF Goju-Kai (Japan)

The club and each of its members are affiliated to Goju-Ryu Seiwakai International. Seiwaikai is associated with JKF Goju-Kai Japan. This style is solely focused on Goju and forms the key stone to our karate. This association gives our club and more importantly our grades (ranks) authenticity and true value. We have a truly powerful association with many affiliates worldwide. This affiliation fee is also used to aid in bringing our worldwide Chief Instructor (Hanshi Seiichi Fujiwara) or other guest Instructors to South Africa annually. The most important point of this affiliation is that we have a direct link to Japan.

2. Morgan Moss Karate International (MMKI)

The club and each of its members are affiliated to MMKI. MMKI is an association that is focused on maintaining our traditional lineage as well as focusing on high performance sports karate within WKF. This association gives our club and each of its affiliated members the opportunity to interact and train with some of the best karate traditionalists and sport athletes in the world.

3. West Rand Karate Federation (WRKF)

The dojo is situated in the West Rand Region and therefore the club and each of its members are affiliated to the West Rand Karate Federation. This allows members the opportunity to participate at a <u>regional level</u>. Regional colours can be obtained here giving students the right to participate at a provincial level. West Rand Karate Federation is an all-styles federation.

4. Gauteng Karate Federation (GKF)

West Rand Karate Federation forms part of the Gauteng Karate Federation. The club and each of its members are affiliated to the Gauteng Karate Federation. This allows members the opportunity to participate at a **provincial level**. Provincial colours can be obtained here giving students the right to participate at a national level. Gauteng Karate Federation is an all-styles federation.



5. Karate South Africa (KSA)

Gauteng Karate Federation forms part of Karate South Africa. The club and each of its members are affiliated to Karate South Africa. This allows members the opportunity to participate at a <u>national level</u>. National colours (Protea Colours) can be obtained here giving students the right to participate at an international level. <u>Karate South Africa is the official body recognized by SASCOC, IOC and most importantly, the WKF</u>. Karate South Africa is an all-styles federation.

6. Union of African Karate Federations (UFAK)

Karate South Africa forms part of the Union of African Karate Federations. Through the club's affiliation to KSA, members have the opportunity to represent South Africa at various Continental levels (Region 5 and African Championships). This allows members the opportunity to participate at a **continental level**. Union of African Karate Federation is an all-styles federation.

7. World Karate Federation (WKF)

Karate South Africa forms part of the World Karate Federation. Through the club's affiliation to KSA, members have the opportunity to represent South Africa at various WKF events (WKF World Championships, WKF Premier League, WKF Series A, WKF Youth League, WKF World Cup, etc). This allows members the opportunity to participate at the https://doi.org/10.1001/jhepst.com/html. The WKF is officially recognized by the International Olympic Committee as the controlling body of karate. World Karate Federation is an all-styles federation.

8. South Africa Goju-ryu Karate Federation (SAGF) & African Goju-ryu Karate Federation (AGKF)

Both these bodies allow the club and its members to engage in competitions and seminars at a national and continental level. These events are only open to Goju karate-ka which offers the club and its members the opportunity to further its knowledge and experience in the world of Goju.



9. World Goju-Ryu Karate Federation (WGKF)

SAGF & AGKF forms part of the World Goju-Ryu Karate Federation. Through the club's affiliation to SAGF & AGKF, members have the opportunity to represent South Africa at various WGKF events (WGKF World Championships, WGKF Seminars, etc). This allows members the opportunity to participate at the https://disable.com/highest-level-in-Goju-Ryu. The World Goju-Ryu Karate Federation is recognized by the WKF.

DEVELOPMENT & EQUIPMENT FEE

Annual Amount: R 300.00 (Maximum 2 per family)

Deadline: 31 March 2023

This annual development and equipment fee are a compulsory fee for all members of the dojo and has been included to upgrade and maintain the club's high-quality service. The tatami (matts) plays an important role in the development and safety of all our students. The tatami has a 2/3-year life span at most and costs R 60 000. In 2021 we managed to replace the tatami. Our priority in 2023 will be to replace old equipment, purchase super bands and assist our development clubs. The development and equipment fee have also been put into place to upgrade the knowledge base and skill level of the instructors' team (Instructor's training, Instructor's seminar, etc). We believe that combining up to date, knowledgeable and scientific training, with state-of-the-art equipment will not only increase the level of each student at the club but provide a quality professional service. The development and equipment fee forms only a small part of what continues to be an extremely challenging fundraising effort. In 2019 the dojo underwent a full-face lift, and I am sure each and every member has enjoyed the upgrade fully.



Tuition fees have increased slightly from 2022.

This monthly fee is a compulsory fee for all affiliated traditional members of the dojo and should be settled in advance by the 7th of each month. *This fee is payable for 12 months of the year including months where holidays occur.* This fee covers all traditional classes and excludes all specialized tournament class fees, grading fees, competition and seminar fees. These classes are taught by either Sensei Morgan and/or a member of his appointed team of instructors.

TUITION FEE (PRE-KARATE: 4 – 5 YEARS)

Monthly Amount: R 450.00 Deadline: 7th of each month

Tuition fees have increased slightly from 2022.

This monthly fee is a compulsory fee for all 4/5-year-old members of the dojo and should be settled in advance by the 7th of each month. *This fee is payable for 12 months of the year including months where holidays occur.* This fee covers all pre-karate classes and excludes all specialized tournament class fees, grading fees, competition and seminar fees. These classes are taught by either Sensei Morgan and/or a member of his appointed team of instructors.

TOURNAMENT CLASS FEES

Cadet, Juniors and Seniors Tournament Class Monthly Amount: R 350.00

Cadet, Juniors and Seniors Tournament Class Monthly Amount: R 750.00 (For

students who only train in the Tournament Class Program)



Deadline: 7th of each month

Tournament fees remain the same since 2015. Members who only train in the Tournament program are charged a full fee. Students are invited to attend tournament classes. These classes offer highly specialized training geared at competing in the sports component of karate. This monthly fee is a compulsory fee for all members involved in the tournament class program and should be settled in advance by the 7th of each month. This fee is payable for 12 months of the year including months where holidays occur. This fee covers all tournament classes and excludes all traditional class fees, grading fees, competition, and seminar fees. Tournament classes have no impact on the frequency of grading and cannot be substituted for traditional classes. All members of Morgan Moss Karate who would like to be involved in the tournament classes need to be active members in traditional class or affiliated to a traditional program. We are after all a karate club and not a sports club. These classes are taught by either Sensei Morgan and/or a member of his appointed team of instructors.

GRADINGS

White - Orange Belt Test: R 300.00

Green - Blue Belt Test: R 350.00

Purple – Brown Belt Test: R 400.00

Standardization Test: R 500.00

Deadline: Payment in cash before the day of grading (No EFT)

Grading or testing takes place throughout the year and is per invitation only. Only students who have met the relevant criteria will be invited to grade. Blue-Brown Belts grade no more than three times per year; White-Green Belts grade no more than four times a year & Pre-karate student's grade no more than four times per year. Grading fees need to be settled in cash (No EFT) prior to the grading. Please note that this fee covers certification as well as evaluation/report cards. Belts are now included in the grading fee should you/your child be upgraded to a new belt colour level.



COMPETITIONS & SEMINAR/GASHKYU

Competitions and seminars take place regularly and students are encouraged to attend. Many seminars form vital components in the development of students. A detailed list of various competitions and seminars can be obtained in the dojo. Payments need to be in cash before the entry deadline. No EFT will be accepted. No late entries will be accepted.

Private Sessions remain a priority for many top karate-ka. This fee is payable in cash upon booking. All bookings need to be done with Sensei Morgan in person or via email. Hereafter Sensei Morgan will allocate a time slot for the private. Privates will be done by one of a team of instructors during 2023. Please note that all programs and sessions are carefully designed by Sensei Morgan. Private Sessions do not make up for missed traditional classes. No refunds for missed private sessions.
