Please note the additional COVID19 requirements:

- 1. Event Timetable to be sent out divisions times will be separated
- 2. ALL Athletes must use ALL THE REQUIRED PROTECTIVE GEAR REFERENCED IN THE WKF RULES 2023 - WKF Protective gear must be used. Athletes MUST carry their own sanitizer – with 70% alcohol base. SHIN/ FOOTER PADS and MITS will have to be sanitized before/ after each bout. NO SHARING OF EQUIPMENT WILL BE ALLOWED.

3. Only selected ACCREDITED PROVINCIAL coaches (Maximum 5 per Province) will be allowed (once accredited by KSA Technical Convener-Shihan Brando Pillay. Only appointed coaches from each PROVINCE may coach an athlete from his/ her PROVINCE (WHO HAVE ATTENDED THE TECHNICAL CONFERENCE 2023 and the COACHES COURSE 2023).

GENERAL INFORMATION

 Age of athletes for this tournament will be calculated as the age on 24th October 2023- in line with the World Championship

- All athletes must be <u>medically fit</u> before they can be allowed to participate.
- This is an Official National Elite Event and only registered members from the affiliated provinces may enter- PLEASE CARRY YOU KSA CARD – no card no entry.

- Athletes take part at their own risk. No claim may be made against KSA WKF or any of the officials officiating on the day of the championship.
- 2. <u>No late entries will be accepted, provinces must confirm with the Tournament</u> Director prior the closing date to ensure that entries has been received.
- 3. It is the responsibility of every Provincial Coach to explain the conditions/ rules to each athlete and or parent before entering the championship.
- 4. <u>Any athlete entered in an incorrect age or weight division will be disqualified</u>. Coaches and Team Managers must ensure that correct information is submitted.
- 5. Any athlete not reporting to his/her floor after 3-call out will be disqualified.
- 6. Tournaments will run BASED on rules discussed at the Technical Congress 2023, and Referees Courses 2023.
- 7. Body protectors are compulsory for female & Male competitors. Athletes MUST carry their own sanitizer with 70% alcohol based as per legislation. Sanitizer will be made available SHIN/ FOOTER PADS and MITS will have to be sanitized before/ after each bout. NO SHARING OF EQUIPMENT WILL BE ALLOWED.

Mouth guards, red/blue mitts, foot and shin guards are also compulsory

Coaches:

- 1. Only the accredited, appointed coaches from each provinces may coach an athlete from his/ her province(5 Coaches per province).
- 2. Only coaches wearing their **full provincial tracksuit** will be allowed to coach. Those wearing only tracksuit top or trouser/ Jeans or Protea track suit wont be allowed on the floor.

Team Managers:

- 1. ALL TEAMS MUST HAVE A TEAM MANAGER PRESENT FOR THE FULL DURATION OF THE EVENT- FAILURE TO HAVE A TEAM MANAGER PRESENT WILL RESULT IN 1 COACH BEING REMOVED FROM COACHING AND MADE A TEAM MANAGER FOR THE DURATION OF THE EVENT.
- 2. Team Managers must wear their official Provincial Attire (Navy blue blazer, white shirt, tie, gray pants, black shoes & socks)

- <u>Referees and Judges</u>:
- All officials must be dressed appropriately as per WKF and KSA rules, including table officials.

It is required that all athletes must bring along the following:

- Consent letter from parent/ Guardian/Indemnity form
- Forms MUST be filled in and signed by Parents or Legal Guardian NOT by a Coach or Karate Instructor
